


Submitting Clinical Teacher Absence Reports

LENGTH OF SEMESTER

The clinical teaching semester has been designated as 65 days (but may be extended as necessary) according to TEA, the department guidelines and/or student's performance.

ATTENDANCE

Clinical teachers are expected to be in attendance at their cooperating school each day. Leaving the school campus during the school day is not permitted without prior approval. It is the responsibility of the clinical teacher to inform the cooperating teacher, university supervisor and school office as soon as possible if absent. All absences must be officially reported through the online Student Data Portal and made up.
