Secondary Graduate Certification Program

One of the features of the Secondary Graduate Certification Program is that the course work completed for certification can be applied to the Master of Education (M.Ed.) degree. A minimum of 21 hours of the certification plan will count toward the 36-hour M.Ed. degree. Students should see their assigned advisor for information on the required additional courses.
