Visiting Assistant Professor Position in Teacher Education/Culture and Curriculum

The Department of Teaching, Learning and Culture invites applications for a **Visiting Assistant Professor** to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in **teacher education**. **Required qualifications** include a) an earned doctorate in curriculum and instruction with an emphasis in teacher education, multicultural education, or culture and curriculum, or closely related field is required, b) application and integration of new technologies in teacher education and/or teaching and learning; c) undergraduate and K-12 teaching experiences, and d) commitment to serving diverse and underrepresented populations and engagement in professional leadership activities. **Preferred qualifications** include a) experience in teaching teacher education courses and/or multicultural education courses; b) experience with multiple teaching formats (e.g., face-to-face, hybrid, online); c) evidence of effective or promise for post-secondary teaching experience; and d) engagement in service activities within an academic department. **Appointment:** This is a nine-month appointment with 4 courses per semester. The anticipated start date is August 15, 2017. Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications. Appointment is for two years, contingent upon satisfactory annual evaluations. Review of the applications will begin on March 1, 2017 and will continue until the position is filled. Priority will be given to those whose applications are received by March 1, 2017.
