

Teaching Opportunity in Guatemala:

The Inter-American School, founded in 1961, is located in the beautiful highland valley of Quetzaltenango, Guatemala. The school is in need of several teachers for their Christian school for Pre-K through Twelfth Grade. It is not necessary to have a teaching certificate, but it is preferred. The curriculum is taught in English, so it is not necessary for applicants to be Spanish speaking.

The Inter-American School has 146 students, with classes not larger than 15. The student body consists of 66% Guatemalan bilingual children and 24% from the U.S. and various other countries. Most of the teachers are from the U.S. or Canada. The faculty is mission-minded and committed to make the necessary sacrifices to provide a quality and innovative education. The school asks that you make a 2-year commitment. You can be housed with a local family, and will be paid a stipend of approximately \$400 a month. Your transportation to Guatemala can also be paid for.

This would be an amazing opportunity for anyone wishing to learn the Spanish language, enjoy the culture of a beautiful country and people, and enrich the lives of children.
