


Congratulations

Aakash has been selected as a finalist in Stanford University's prestigious Center on Longevity Design Challenge—a remarkable milestone, as he becomes the first student from Texas A&M University to achieve this honor.

His project, "Veritas" (Texas A&M University, USA), is a Canvas course designed to equip young students in Pakistan with fact-checking skills to counter digital misinformation on social media platforms. At a time when intolerance and religious extremism are on the rise, his initiative aims to empower individuals with the tools to discern facts from misinformation, fostering critical thinking and responsible digital engagement.

Aakash is among the top eight global finalists out of 230 teams from 120 universities across 31 countries. They will present their project at Stanford University, USA, in April.
